ENGLISH	Read a story or book about The Seaside	Can you recite The Tongue Twister 'She sells sea shells on the seashore'? Can you make up your own Tongue Twister?	Write a letter to a friend about a pretend day at the beach.	Write a story about finding a magic shell. 	Make a tourist information leaflet about a seaside town eg Brighton
MATHS	Practise writing your numbers. Are they the correct way around? Can you write the numbers in words too? 3 - three	Play the online game 'Hit the Button'. What is the highest score you can get?	Make a 3D sea creature, you could use fabric, playdough or lego. What shapes did you use?	Create your own fish and chip shop menu including prices up to £1.00. Write how much change you would get from £1.00 if you buy one or more items. Why don't you try change from £2.00	Find the size of the 5 different oceans and order them from biggest to smallest.
SCIENCE	Why is the sea salty?	Design a healthy picnic to take to the seaside. Can you write what food groups you have included? Eg bread for carbohydrate (energy)	Make a sun safety poster 	Create a diagram of a rock pool and label the different creatures that may be found inside.	Find out about the life cycle of a seashore creature and record what you found out. You could do a starfish or a crab etc
